To date, we've recycled more than 100 million pounds of pre- and post-consumer PVC roofing material, with a goal to upcycle 1 million pounds of post-consumer material annually by 2028.

## Recycle Your Roof Program

When a Duro-Last roof reaches the end of its service life, we reclaim the material and repurpose it into new products like ROOF-TRAK® Walkway Pads, PROFLEX® Expansion Joints and Protect-All® Flooring. This program not only benefits the environment but also helps contractors and building owners avoid landfill and dumpster fees – all while contributing to green building certifications such as LEED®, Green Globes® and the Living Building Challenge®.

# How to Participate in the Recycle Your Roof Program

Duro-Last's commitment to sustainability provides lasting benefits for both the planet and your business. Join us in reducing waste and building a greener future – one roof at a time.

## Qualifications

- Only mechanically fastened Duro-Last **PVC** roofs qualify for recycling
- Membranes must be free of stones, asphalt and roof coating products
- Screws, plates and accessories must be removed

## Preparing the Roofing Material

- Cut out fastening tabs and roll up the membrane
- Secure rolls by welding or tying them
- Optionally, fold or cut material into pallet-sized sheets
- Secure material to a pallet for transport

## Scheduling & Transport

- Send photos and pallet count to Duro-Last for approval
- Schedule pickup with Duro-Last logistics team
- Duro-Last covers transportation costs
