The elevated design helps protect the roof assembly from compression and membrane degradation and supports the long-term performance expected from commercial roofing systems.

By pairing SWIF with custom-fabricated stack flashings and details, Duro-Last formalizes a more integrated relationship between roofing systems and solar arrays. The system allows maintenance, repair and even roof replacement without removing photovoltaic panels, shifting the focus from installation convenience to lifecycle performance.
